Personal characteristics

Adjectives connected with money and giving things:

mean, generous

Adjectives connected with attitude to work:

hardworking, lazy, organized, disorganized, tidy, messy

Adjectives connected with temperament:

impulsive, level-headed, outgoing, shy, optimistic, pessimistic, talkative, quiet

Adjectives connected with relationships:

sensitive, tactless, proud, jealous, rude, polite, obedient, cheeky

Adjectives connected with danger:

cowardly, brave

Adjectives connected with the mind:

clever intelligent, sensible, silly, thick

Expressing an opinion (and reacting positively or negatively to someone else's opinion)
